

ASP District Medallions

The ASP District Medallions are presented to the top image in each of the five districts: Western, Southwestern, North Central, Northeast and Southeast (see graphic below). The Medallion Awards are selected by District from ASP Images of Distinction (IOD) Round 2 images that receive a score of 85 or higher plus the ASP State Elite winners. Images selected for Gold, Silver or Bronze Medallions will not be eligible for District Medallions.

There are five ASP District Medallion Awards, one for each District. Images can only be judged in the maker's home district, which is determined by the maker's mailing address on record. One winning image from each district will receive the ASP District Medallion.

The Gold, Silver and Bronze Medallions and the District Medallions are judged sequentially by two different jury panels. After Gold, Silver and Bronze Medallion winners are selected from all the images scoring 85 or more in the (IOD) Round 2, a separate jury panel selects the five District winners from the remaining IOD Round 2 images scoring 85 or higher plus the State Elite winners. There is no separate entry required for the District Medallion judging.

Note: If an image scores 85 or above in IOD Round 1 and the maker chooses to break the seal for entry into IOD Round 2, the image must again receive a score of 85 or above in IOD Round 2 to be eligible for a Gold, Silver or Bronze Medallion or a District Medallion.

Districts for members submitting from foreign countries not identified on the map will be determined by the Board on a case-by-case basis.

State Elite Award winners from October 1 of the previous year through September 30 of the current year are eligible to be considered for District Medallions.
