

The Gold, Silver and Bronze Medallion Awards

The Gold, Silver and Bronze Medallion Awards are presented to the makers of the top three entries in the ASP <u>Images of Distinction</u>, as judged by a separate panel of jurors. Winners are selected from all the images that score 85 or above in the (IOD) Round 2 plus the <u>ASP State Elite winners</u>.

Gold will be named the Best of Show; Silver will be named the First Runner-up and Bronze will be named Second Runner-up.

The Gold, Silver and Bronze Medallion images will receive a special designation in the ASP Image Excellence Collection. Images that receive a Gold, Silver or Bronze Medallion are not eligible to be judged for District Medallions.

The Gold, Silver and Bronze Medallions and the <u>District Medallions</u> are judged sequentially by two different jury panels. After Gold, Silver and Bronze Medallion winners are selected from all the images scoring 85 or more in the (IOD) Round 2, a separate jury panel selects the five District winners from the remaining IOD Round 2 images scoring 85 or higher plus the State Elite winners. There is no separate entry required for the District Medallion judging.

Note: If an image scores 85 or above in IOD Round 1 and the maker chooses to break the seal for entry into IOD Round 2, the image must again receive a score of 85 or above in IOD Round 2 to be eligible for a Gold, Silver or Bronze Medallion or a District Medallion.

State Elite Award winners from October 1 of the previous year through September 30 of the current year are eligible to be considered for Medallions.
