The ASP Medallion Awards Process and Rules

There are five ASP District Medallion Awards, one for each District. The districts are determined by the area of the country in which the entrants compete (see the graphic). One winning image from each district will receive the ASP District Medallion from that district. Images which win an ASP Gold, Silver or Bronze Medallion Award are not eligible for District Medallions.

ASP <u>District</u> Medallion Awards are presented to the top image in each of the five districts. They are selected by District from IOD Round #2 images scoring 85 or more plus the State Elite winners from each District. Images selected for Gold, Silver and Bronze Medallion Awards will not be eligible for District Medallions.

Process

A jury panel selects the Gold, Silver and Bronze awards from all the images scoring 85 or more in the Images of Distinction (IOD) Round #2. Then a separate jury panel selects the five District winners from the remaining IOD Round #2 images scoring 85 or higher plus each of the State Elite winners in the District. There is no separate entry required for the Medallion Awards.

Note: If an image scores 85 or above in IOD Round 1 and the seal is broken, the image must again score 85 or above in IOD round 2 to be eligible for one of these awards. ASP State Elite Award winners from October 1 of the previous year through September 30 of the current year are eligible for ASP Medallions.

Districts are determined per the map (Image 1). Districts for members submitting from foreign countries not identified on the map will be determined by the Board on a case-by-case basis.
